

MCCOC Chamber Awards Nominations

The Marshall County Chamber of Commerce is seeking nominations for its annual awards. Awards will be presented at the Annual Chamber Banquet on Thursday, February 16th. Nominees must be residents of, or businesses located in, Marshall County. Nominations are due in the Chamber office by 5 pm on Monday, February 6th, and must have the name and phone number for the person who is making the nomination. Nominations are being accepted for the following awards:

2016 Large Business of the Year

A current Chamber member/business with twenty-six or more employees. Tenure, overall quality of service, and contribution to the general high quality of the County's business community shall be considered for this award.

2016 Small Business of the Year

A current Chamber member/business with twenty-five or fewer employees. Tenure, overall quality of service, and contribution to the general high quality of the County's business community shall be considered for this award.

2016 Community Investment Award

An individual or organization that makes a significant expansion or commercial business investment in Marshall County.

2016 Raymond Gary Leadership Award

A Marshall County citizen that has contributed in significant ways to Marshall County's economic growth and development. The contributions may be at the local, town or County level.

2016 Katye Hayward Volunteer of the Year

A Marshall County citizen with an outstanding record of local or county-wide volunteer service. Preference shall be afforded to the individual with the greatest geographic service.

2016 Humanitarian of the Year

A Marshall County citizen that works to make other peoples' lives better.
